




Nailing the perfect shot!



Sukanya unveils her secret recipe to make the perfect Three-Tier Eggless Chocolate Cake at home with ease using only eight ingredients:-

INGREDIENTS

- 1 cup All-purpose flour
- 1 cup Sugar Dust
- 1 teaspoon Baking Powder
- ½ teaspoon Baking Soda
- ½ cup Cocoa Powder
- 3/4 cup Curd
- ½ cup Butter
- 1.5 Teaspoon Chocolate Essence





Prep Time: 1 Hour



Servings: 20

METHOD

- Mix all the dry ingredients first- All-purpose flour, sugar dust, baking powder, baking soda and cocoa powder until there are no lumps.
- Next mix all the wet ingredients- melted butter, curd, and chocolate essence until smooth batter is obtained.
- Put all of the ingredients in a bowl and combine until smooth and aerated, with a hand beater.
- Make each cake separately. Start with the bottom tier.
- Pour batter into greased cake pan and bake the cake in OTG oven in bake mode for about 45 mins. at 180° C until the cakes are baked through.
- To test for doneness, insert a toothpick into the center of the cake. If it comes out clean, it's done.
- After cooling use a large serrated knife and slice a thin layer off the tops of all the cakes to create a flat surface.
- Stack the cakes directly on top of one another starting with the base cake.
- Decorate the cake with melted dark chocolate. Top with sprinkles, if desired.
- Serve and enjoy.






